Dear Mr. Standley:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 6, 2018. 321 requests an extension of the STA granted on September 20, 2017, to continue operating with the daytime pattern at night using reduced power to allow time to repair the hurricane damaged tower and then file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters. In support of the request, we note that 321 will need additional time to complete repairs and file the application in order to restore licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and 321 may continue to operate with 0.25 kW at night using the stations daytime directional antenna pattern (with no change to the licensed 5 kW daytime DA facility). 321 must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are

necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires September 28, 2018.
