Dear Mr. Fuss:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change applications filed by Delta Radio Network, LLC ("Delta") for commercial FM Stations WDTL(FM), Indianola; and WIQQ(FM), Leland, Mississippi. For the reason stated below, the applications will be dismissed.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1910, the Commission examines applications to determine if the applicant is delinquent in any non-tax debt owed to the Commission.¹ On July 25, 2017, you were notified that Delta was delinquent on the payment of debts owed to the Federal Communications Commission. The red light letter indicated that if full payment or satisfactory arrangement to pay the delinquent debt was not made within 30 days of the date of the letter, the applications would be dismissed. As of this date, the Commission has not received payment of the debts identified in the red light letter, nor have satisfactory payment arrangements been made.

For the purpose of determining if an applicant is delinquent the Commission checks the status of all entities with whom an applicant shares the same tax payer identification number.

Accordingly, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Sections 1.1910(b)(3) and 0.283, WDTL's Application BPH-20160502AAE and WIQQ's Application BPH-20150302AAV ARE HEREBY DISMISSED.
