On April 2, 2018, we received your comments asking that we investigate the operational history of the referenced station in connection with the referenced application for special temporary authority (Application). We will treat your comments as an informal objection to the Application.<sup>1</sup>

You apparently are not aware that the Commission designated a hearing to determine whether or not to grant the station's license renewal application due to the station's operating history.<sup>2</sup> Any action that we take on the Application is without prejudice to the Commission's decision as to the station's license renewal application. Accordingly, we will grant the Application and deny your informal objection.
