MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER adopted 7-27-78, released 8-11-78 FCC 78-528 95760: Therefore, in light of the above discussion, IT IS ORDERED, That the informal objections filed by the Committee on Children's Television-North, et al, against nine San Francisco area licensees identified in footnote 1 and the informal objection filed by the Committee on Children's Television-South against seven Los Angeles licensees identified in footnote 2 ARE DENIED to the extent they seek hearings on the specific license renewals of these particular stations and GRANTED to the extent that they seek reinstatement of the Commission's Children's Inquiry and incorporation of the arguments and data therein provided as part of that Inquiry. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the pleadings and filings of this proceeding are made a part of the inquiry in Docket 19142.

MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER adopted 10-24-78, released 11-2-78 FCC 78-961 4307: Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the Petition to Deny filed by the Committee on Children's Television and the Bay Area Hispanic Institute for Advancement IS DENIED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the application of Bahia De San Francisco Television Company for renewal of license for Station KDTV, San Francisco, California, IS GRANTED.

REPORT AND ORDER adopted 6-28-78, released 7-14-78 FCC 78-467 95508: Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED That pursuant to authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(d)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the Television Table of Assignments (Section 73.606(b) of the Rules) IS AMENDED, effective August 21, 1978, with respect to the following communities: San Francisco, California 14+. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, the outstanding license of Bahia de San Francisco TV Co. for Station KDTV(TV) IS MODIFIED, effective August 21, 1978, to specify operation on UHF TV Channel 14 instead of on UHF TV Channel 60. The licensee shall inform the Commission in writing by no later than August 21, 1978, of its acceptance of this modification. Station KFTV may continue to operate on Channel 60 for one year from the effective date of this action or until it is ready to operate on Channel 14, whichever is earlier, unless the Commission directs otherwise. In addition, the following information shall be provided. (a) At least 30 days before commencing operation on Channel 14, the licensee of Station KDTV shall submit to the Commission the technical information normally required of an applicant for the channel, including that connected with a change in the transmitter site. (b) At least 10 days prior to commencing operation on Channel 14, the licensee of Station KDTV shall submit the measurement data required of an applicant for a broadcast station license; and (c) The licensee of Station KFTV shall not commence operation on Channel 14 without prior Commission authorization. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.

About the History Cards ...

History Cards were first used by the Department of Commerce to keep track of applications filed by, and changes to, the earliest AM broadcast radio stations in the early 1920s. The records were subsequently transferred to the Federal Radio Commission in 1927, and after that to the Federal Communications Commission when that agency was created in 1934. These cards gradually grew into a large card file.

TV History Cards were initiated in the early 1940s, with the authorization of the earliest TV stations. History Cards remained in use until the creation of the first computerized database in 1980 to track broadcast applications, the Broadcast Application Processing System (BAPS). However, the Commission did not transfer the data from the History Cards to the new system. Instead, it retained the History Cards in their original form for reference.

In 1999, the Commission moved to a new location (445 12th Street SW), and also at that time created the successor database to BAPS, the Consolidated DataBase System (CDBS). Prior to that move, the History Cards were transferred to microfiche by a contractor (only a few sets of microfiche exist), and the original paper cards were destroyed. The History Cards were stored on the microfiche as negative images, like those you see above.

History Cards contain very brief entries and notes about station facilities, applications, and ownership. They are not, and never were intended to be, a comprehensive record of a station's operations. Nevertheless, they can be useful to help determine, for example, when a station first went on the air and its call letters at that time. History Card comments were generally typed onto the cards, and thus some records will show more faintly or with more smudging than others, depending on the quality of typewriter and ribbon then used. Occasional handwritten comments, corrections, and strikeouts may also be found. Cards may be incomplete, missing, or occasionally out of sequence.

The History Cards are presented here as they were copied to microfiche, to preserve this record for public use, and with the hope that they will be of value to future researchers of television station history.
