(FLBI), this letter acknowledges FLBI's acceptance of the following condition to be imposed by a modified Construction Permit for KFLB-FM issued pursuant to the above-referenced application for minor modification of Construction Permit BPED-20060320AFQ, dated June 9, 2006.

"This application is being granted prior to the completion of the international notification process. Therefore, any construction or operation with the facilities specified herein is at applicant's own risk and subject to modification, suspension or termination without right to hearing, if objected to by the Secretaria de Comunicaciones Y Transportes (SCT) in Mexico or if found by the Commission or the SCT to be necessary in order to conform to the 1992 USA-Mexico FM Broadcasting Agreement. This condition will be removed if formal acceptance of the facilities granted herein is received from STC."
