Dear Licensee--

Our records indicate that the station referenced above has been silent since at least June 2, 2016. Therefore, pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended,^[1] the station's license expired as a matter of law at 12:01 a.m., June 3, 2017. It appears that this may be an oversight on your part. Please respond as soon as possible to this email with the date the station resumed operation so that we can update our records. If we do not receive a response within 30 days of the date of this email that our records incorrectly reflect the operational status of the station and that, in fact, the station returned to the air with authorized facilities at some time between June 2, 2016, and 12:01 a.m., June 3, 2017, the Commission's public and internal databases WILL BE MODIFIED to indicate that the broadcast license for the referenced station is EXPIRED, that the station's license is CANCELED as a matter of law, and that the station's call sign is DELETED.
