Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 27, 2018. Citicasters requests an extension of the STA granted on October 2, 2017, to continue operating at night using the daytime pattern to allow time to file an FCC Form 301 application (due to the destruction of one tower).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Citicasters stated that it is preparing the application for filing.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Citicasters may continue to operate at night using the daytime DA pattern with a maximum nominal power of 0.25 kW (with no change to the licensed 5 kW DA daytime operation).



<sup>1</sup> WDDV(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1320 kHz with 5 kW day and 1 kW night using different patterns.

Citicasters must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 2, 2018**.
