Dear Mr. Kidd:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 30, 2018. URL requests a further extension of the STA granted on August 6, 2010, to continue operating from an alternate site pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 license applications to cover the WLAY and WVNA construction permits.\(^1\) In support of the request, we note that URL did not file the two license applications.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and URL may
