

Dear Mr. Walls:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 16, 2018. CCBL requests a further extension of the STA granted in 1981 to continue operating using 10 kW patterns to overcome Cuban interference.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CCBL states that the interference continues.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and CCBL may continue to operate with the 10 kW patterns specified in BMML-20170426ACK using the licensed towers. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CCBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. CCBL must resume the licensed 5 kW operation if the Cuban interference ceases, or upon official notice from the Commission. This authority expires on **November 9, 2018**.
