Dear Counsel,

This letter refers to the "Informal Objection" filed by Tiger Eye Broadcasting, Inc. (TEBC) in connection with Sunshine State Television Networks, Inc.'s (Sunshine) application for consent to assign the license of station KOHC-CD, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to HC2 Station Group, Inc.¹ TEBC requested that we condition our grant of the assignment "on the fulfillment of Sunshine's financial obligations to TEBC" or delay our decision until after TEBC's contractual dispute with Sunshine is resolved.² On May 22, 2018, TEBC filed a motion to withdraw its Informal Objection.³ TEBC certifies that its withdrawal complies with the requirements of Section 73.3588(b) of the Commission's rules,⁴ and states that it neither received nor will receive any consideration relating to the request for withdrawal.

Accordingly, we **GRANT** the request for withdrawal and **DISMISS** the Informal Objection.
