Dear Mr. Jones:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 23, 2018. SFL requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 17, 2016, to continue operating with parameters at variance due to on-going work at the new light rail station located adjacent to the transmitter site.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, SFL states that additional time will be needed pending completion of the project.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and SFL may continue to operate with day and night parameters at variance and/or reduced power while



maintaining nighttime monitor points within licensed limits. SFL must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. SFL must submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station was able to resume licensed operations per BML-20130821ADN with negligible changes to all operating parameters after work on the light rail station has been completed.

This authority expires on **December 13, 2018**.
