Dear Mr. Kennedy:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 25, 2018. ELL requests an extension of the STA granted on March 26, 2018, to continue operating with parameters at variance at the KNCW transmitter site pending further action on BL-20180510ABB.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we noted that the application remains pending at this time.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is GRANTED, and EEL may continue to operate with parameters at variance (and reduced power if needed) based upon the information



provided in the application. ELL must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 14, 2018**.
