Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Couzens:

This letter concerns the request you filed on May 4, 2018, on behalf of Peace and Justice Network of San Joaquin County (PJNSJC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit Low Power FM Station KXVS-LP to remain silent.


Commission records reflect that PJNSJC stated that Station KXVS-LP went silent on September 26, 2017, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on November 1, 2017, and expired on April 30, 2018. PJNSJC requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

PJNSJC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KXVS-LP to remain silent until September 26, 2018. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KXVS-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 27, 2018.**<sup>1</sup>

PJNSJC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If PJNSJC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
