Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a minor change to a licensed facility.

Pursuant to Section 17.4(a) of the Commission's Rules,¹ any proposed construction of a new antenna structure or proposed alteration of an existing antenna structure that requires notification to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires registration with the Commission prior to construction or alteration. KHGV-LP was notified on February 22, 2018 of the tower registration requirement. To date there has been no substantial progress demonstrated toward obtaining the antenna structure registration number. The staff made the initial contact with Claude Parker requesting updates of progress or delays in securing tower registration.

Accordingly, to date, four months have passed since the application was filed with an antenna location that requires antenna structure registration. No tangible evidence has been presented showing that the proposed antenna structure has been registered or that a different site has been proposed by amendment of the application.

KHGV-LP's overall lack of responsiveness and failure to periodically file status updates of the tower registration process leaves the application subject to dismissal.

Nevertheless, we are affording KHGV-LP with one final opportunity to file an amendment that either provides a tower registration number or proposes changes to site parameters that comply with antenna structure registration requirements.

Further action on application BPL-20180215AAE will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide the applicant an opportunity to file the requested amendment. Failure to correct all remaining grantability defects within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1).
