IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the above-captioned 1972 license renewal application for Station WCBS-TV, New York, New York, IS GRANTED, subject to the following conditions:

MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER:

that any action has been taken to fulfill that commitment. Neither has CBS advanced any arguments to challenge our determination, supported by the Court, 21/ that our emphasis on physical presence is the appropriate approach to relieving the New Jersey television service problem. For these reasons, we approve of CBS's "plans" to the limited extent that they have been revealed to us, but CBS's renewal applications for WCBS-TV, New York, New York and WCAU-TV, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania cannot be granted at this time. Rather, we will consider them again with the aid of the additional information we are requiring CBS to submit infra, at paragraph 58.

49. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That all of the petitions to deny and informal objections filed in this matter by the New Jersey Coalition for Fair Broadcasting, by the Governor of New Jersey, by the New Jersey Legislature, and by the Department of the Public Advocate for the State of New Jersey ARE DENIED, except to the extent indicated in paragraph 52.

50. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the following renewal applications ARE GRANTED: National Broadcasting Company, Inc. for Station WNBC-TV, New York, New York; Metromedia, Inc. for Station WNEW-TV, New York, New York; WPIX, Inc. for WPIX-TV, New York, New York; Westinghouse Broadcasting Company, Inc. 22/ for Station KYW-TV, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and Capital Cities Communications, Inc. for Station WPVI-TV, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

51. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That each of the eight licensees involved in this proceeding shall submit with its next renewal or supplemental renewal application, a statement describing its utilization of its New Jersey facilities and its programming designed to serve the problems, needs and interests of the residents of New Jersey; RKO General, Inc. shall submit its statement for association with WOR-TV's license file on the date that renewal applications are next due for New York television stations.

52. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That Capital Cities Communications, Inc. shall submit, within six months from the release of this Order, a description of the size and layout of its planned Trenton facility, and of its location and accessibility to New Jersey residents, and of the time it is expected to begin operations.

53. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That WPIX, Inc. shall submit, within six months from the release of this Order, a description of the size and layout of the facility it has established in fulfillment of its commitment made in this proceeding, its accessibility to New Jersey residents, and the nature and timing of WPIX-TV's promotional announcements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That CBS, Inc. shall submit, within six months from the release of this Order, as amendments to its 1981 supplemental renewal applications for WCBS-TV, New York, New York, and WCAU-TV, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, descriptions of the size and layout, and the location and accessibility to New Jersey residents of the facilities which it intends to establish in fulfillment of its commitments made in this proceeding, the dates of completion or a progress report with expected dates of completion, the manner in which the public will become informed of their existence, and an explanation of the time its New Jersey personnel and equipment will spend in New Jersey, and how they will contribute in that time to CBS's fulfillment of its special obligation to serve New Jersey.

55. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the Broadcast Bureau shall send by Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested, a copy of this Memorandum Opinion and Order to each of the parties to this proceeding.

## About the History Cards ...

History Cards were first used by the Department of Commerce to keep track of applications filed by, and changes to, the earliest AM broadcast radio stations in the early 1920s. The records were subsequently transferred to the Federal Radio Commission in 1927, and after that to the Federal Communications Commission when that agency was created in 1934. These cards gradually grew into a large card file.

TV History Cards were initiated in the early 1940s, with the authorization of the earliest TV stations. History Cards remained in use until the creation of the first computerized database in 1980 to track broadcast applications, the Broadcast Application Processing System (BAPS). However, the Commission did not transfer the data from the History Cards to the new system. Instead, it retained the History Cards in their original form for reference.

In 1999, the Commission moved to a new location (445 12<sup>th</sup> Street SW), and also at that time created the successor database to BAPS, the Consolidated DataBase System (CDBS). Prior to that move, the History Cards were transferred to microfiche by a contractor (only a few sets of microfiche exist), and the original paper cards were destroyed. The History Cards were stored on the microfiche as negative images, like those you see above.

History Cards contain very brief entries and notes about station facilities, applications, and ownership. They are not, and never were intended to be, a comprehensive record of a station's operations. Nevertheless, they can be useful to help determine, for example, when a station first went on the air and its call letters at that time. History Card comments were generally typed onto the cards, and thus some records will show more faintly or with more smudging than others, depending on the quality of typewriter and ribbon then used. Occasional handwritten comments, corrections, and strikeouts may also be found. Cards may be incomplete, missing, or occasionally out of sequence.

The History Cards are presented here as they were copied to microfiche, to preserve this record for public use, and with the hope that they will be of value to future researchers of television station history.
