Dear Mr. Driscoll:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 4, 2018. CML requests an extension of the STA granted on December 21, 2017, to operate with reduced power due to the removal of the station's roof top ground system by a third party.¹ In support of the request, CML states that it plans to replace the ground system in the upcoming months in order to move forward toward resumption of licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CML may continue to operate with reduced power. CML must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. CML must file an FCC Form 301 minor change application in the upcoming months if any significant changes are needed. Otherwise an e-mail must

be submitted to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BZ-20070808AEH with negligible changes to all parameters.

This authority expires on **December 21, 2018**.
