MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER issued 12-2-75, released 12-3-75 FCC 75M-2035 58360; Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the Joint Request for Approval, etc., item (a) above, is hereby GRANTED and that the Agreement submitted ~~herewith~~ therewith is approved; and IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That the petition and supplemental petition of Northern Entertainment, Inc., items (b) and (c) above, for leave to amend its application are hereby GRANTED and the amendment and supplemental amendment submitted therewith are ACCEPTED; and IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That the application of Sault Ste. Marie Broadcasting Corp. is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE; and IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That the application of Northern Entertainment, Inc. for a construction permit to construct and operate a new television broadcast station on Channel 8 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan is hereby GRANTED\*, and that this proceeding IS TERMINATED.

\*The ruling granting the Northern Entertainment, Inc. application is, of course, subject to the applicable provisions of Rules 1.302(a) and 1.302(b), with respect to its effectiveness.

ORDER adopted 7-20-79, released 7-20-79 FCC 79-455 14346: On the basis of the information now before us, IT IS ORDERED THAT, pursuant to Section 1.117 of the Rules, the grant of the above-captioned applications by the Chief, Broadcast Bureau, acting under delegated authority, IS SET ASIDE, the applications are returned to pending status, and that an inquiry will follow to determine what further action is appropriate.

## About the History Cards ...

History Cards were first used by the Department of Commerce to keep track of applications filed by, and changes to, the earliest AM broadcast radio stations in the early 1920s. The records were subsequently transferred to the Federal Radio Commission in 1927, and after that to the Federal Communications Commission when that agency was created in 1934. These cards gradually grew into a large card file.

TV History Cards were initiated in the early 1940s, with the authorization of the earliest TV stations. History Cards remained in use until the creation of the first computerized database in 1980 to track broadcast applications, the Broadcast Application Processing System (BAPS). However, the Commission did not transfer the data from the History Cards to the new system. Instead, it retained the History Cards in their original form for reference.

In 1999, the Commission moved to a new location (445 12<sup>th</sup> Street SW), and also at that time created the successor database to BAPS, the Consolidated DataBase System (CDBS). Prior to that move, the History Cards were transferred to microfiche by a contractor (only a few sets of microfiche exist), and the original paper cards were destroyed. The History Cards were stored on the microfiche as negative images, like those you see above.

History Cards contain very brief entries and notes about station facilities, applications, and ownership. They are not, and never were intended to be, a comprehensive record of a station's operations. Nevertheless, they can be useful to help determine, for example, when a station first went on the air and its call letters at that time. History Card comments were generally typed onto the cards, and thus some records will show more faintly or with more smudging than others, depending on the quality of typewriter and ribbon then used. Occasional handwritten comments, corrections, and strikeouts may also be found. Cards may be incomplete, missing, or occasionally out of sequence.

The History Cards are presented here as they were copied to microfiche, to preserve this record for public use, and with the hope that they will be of value to future researchers of television station history.
