Excerpts from The Kerner Commission Report 1968

Important segments of the media failed to report adequately on the causes and consequences of civil disorders and on the underlying problems of race relations.

These failings must be corrected, and the improvement must come from within the industry and the recruitment of more Negroes into journalism and broadcasting and promoted to positions of significant responsibility will be steps in the right direction which is not likely to happen if EMF takes over.

EMF's conservative format is just a 2018 version of the some of the problems sighted by the Commission that will be further exacerbated by the sale of WSHA and the outlet it afforded the city's minority community which would have been even more effective IF the requested Linton Report would have been adopted rather than suppressed by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees for Shaw University.
