CONDITIONS: 1) Subject to the condition that operation with effective radiated power in excess of 1000 kW after April 1, 1975, is subject to a further extension of consent by Canada.

2) Subject to the condition that prior to issuance of program test authority for the construction authorised herein, the permittee shall file with the Commission sufficient field intensity measurements of standard broadcast station WSBT, South Bend, Indiana made both before commencement and after completion of the construction of the antenna structure specified herein, to satisfactorily demonstrate that the radiation patterns have or pattern has not changed because of said construction. Minimum required measurements shall include at least ten (10) point locations for each of eight equally spaced radials.

These measurements shall be submitted in tabulated form. Also, measurement data shall be certified by all parties involved before submission to the Commission. The engineer selected by the permittee to make the measurements shall be acceptable to all parties, and the cost of making the measurements, and any corrective measures that may be required to restore the patterns to the conditions prior to this construction shall be borne by the permittet herein. Also, permittee shall be responsible for maintenance and repair of any detuning circuits installed on the subject antenna supporting structure that may be necessary to restore the radiation patterns of station WSBT, South Bend, Indiana.

Permittee shall not commence construction of the television antenna supporting structure prior to the making of the after measurements on station WSBT by Michiana Telecasting Corporation, Licensee of Station WNDU-TV, South Bend, Indiana demonstrating that the WSBT directional radiation patterns have been restored to their original conditions prior to the construction

of the WNDU-TV antenna system.

About the History Cards ...

History Cards were first used by the Department of Commerce to keep track of applications filed by, and changes to, the earliest AM broadcast radio stations in the early 1920s. The records were subsequently transferred to the Federal Radio Commission in 1927, and after that to the Federal Communications Commission when that agency was created in 1934. These cards gradually grew into a large card file.

TV History Cards were initiated in the early 1940s, with the authorization of the earliest TV stations. History Cards remained in use until the creation of the first computerized database in 1980 to track broadcast applications, the Broadcast Application Processing System (BAPS). However, the Commission did not transfer the data from the History Cards to the new system. Instead, it retained the History Cards in their original form for reference.

In 1999, the Commission moved to a new location (445 12th Street SW), and also at that time created the successor database to BAPS, the Consolidated DataBase System (CDBS). Prior to that move, the History Cards were transferred to microfiche by a contractor (only a few sets of microfiche exist), and the original paper cards were destroyed. The History Cards were stored on the microfiche as negative images, like those you see above.

History Cards contain very brief entries and notes about station facilities, applications, and ownership. They are not, and never were intended to be, a comprehensive record of a station's operations. Nevertheless, they can be useful to help determine, for example, when a station first went on the air and its call letters at that time. History Card comments were generally typed onto the cards, and thus some records will show more faintly or with more smudging than others, depending on the quality of typewriter and ribbon then used. Occasional handwritten comments, corrections, and strikeouts may also be found. Cards may be incomplete, missing, or occasionally out of sequence.

The History Cards are presented here as they were copied to microfiche, to preserve this record for public use, and with the hope that they will be of value to future researchers of television station history.
