Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 11, 2018. AML requests an extension of the STA granted on December 18, 2017, to continue operating ND at night using reduced power to allow time to repair the nighttime antenna system.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, AML states that additional time will be needed to complete all required repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

<sup>1</sup> WING(AM) is licensed for operation on 1410 kHz with 5 kW (ND day and DA night).

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and AML may continue to operate ND at night with a maximum of 1.25 kW (with no change to the daytime ND 5 kW operation). AML must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. AML must submit an e-mail to my attention to verify the date the station was able to resume licensed operations (per BZ-19950328AB) with negligible changes to ensure an FCC Form 302 application filing is not required.

This authority expires on **December 28, 2018**.
