Dear Mr. Kitchen:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 26, 2018. TMTL requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 4, 2012, to continue operation with parameters at variance pending further action on the construction permit application BP-20180702AAR to modify the licensed antenna system.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we noted that additional time must be allowed for our staff to review the application and take further action.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMTL may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power if needed while maintaining nighttime monitor points within licensed limits. TMTL must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect



<sup>1</sup> KOSY(AM) is licensed for operation on 790 kHz with 1 kW (ND) day and 0.5 kW (DA) night, and BP-20180702AAR proposes a correction in coordinates, a reduction in nighttime power, and a change from DA to ND at night.

workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 12, 2019**.
