BROADCAST ACTION

WSTE-TV, FAJARDO, PUERTO RICO, REQUEST FOR CP MODIFICATION SET FOR HEARING

The Commission has designated for hearing the applications of WSTE-TV, Inc., permittee of television station WSTE, Channel 13, Fajardo, Puerto Rico, for extension of time to construct and for modification of construction permit (BMPCT-5777, 6029), and has dismissed WSTE-TV's earlier application for modification of construction permit (BMPCT-5678).

WSTE-TV proposes, in its current request for modification of CP, to relocate its transmitter site approximately 9 miles west of Fajardo, to increase its effective visual radiated power in the horizontal plane to 163 kilowatts, to increase antenna height above average terrain to 2000 feet, and to make other changes. If the modification application is granted, WSTE will place a predicted principal city signal over all of the city of San Juan, approximately 30 miles northwest of Fajardo. WSTE would provide San Juan with its fourth commercial VHF signal.

The Commission made the following organizations parties to the hearing: WAPA-TV Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of station WAPA-TV, San Juan; Telemundo, Inc., licensee of station WKAQ-TV, San Juan; Telesanjuan, Inc., licensee of station WTSJ, San Juan; Amrex Construction Company, Inc., et al., licensees of mobile radio systems with transmitting and receiving facilities in the vicinity of WSTE's proposed site; and the El Yunque Radio Users Advisory Committee, representing operators of a large number of radio facilities in the vicinity of the proposed site.

The Commission denied various petitions filed by WAPA-TV, Telemundo, and Amrex to deny WSTE-TV's modification application, and denied informal objections filed by Telesanjuan and the El Yunque Radio Users Advisory Committee.

The Commission also denied the Petition For Stay of Joaquin Baez, Jr., filed February 26, 1968. Baez had requested stay of the hearing until resolution of a petition for rule making looking toward reassignment of Channel 13 from Fajardo to Mayaguez. The Commission said "...action on the rule making would not be prejudiced by the hearing ordered herein. Therefore, the request for stay will be denied."

Issues designated for hearing are:

1. To determine to what extent the operation of Station WSTE as proposed might cause harmful interference to other radio facilities located on El Yunque Peak, and if harmful interference is caused, the extent to which WSTE-TV, Inc., with the cooperation of the owners and operators of the other radio facilities, should be able to resolve problems of harmful interference to other radio facilities located on El Yunque Peak.
2. To determine whether WSTE-TV, Inc., will have available a \$1,000,000 bank loan from The First National Bank and Trust Company of Oklahoma City to finance the construction and first-year operation of Station WSTE.
3. To determine, in the event that (2) above is resolved in the affirmative, how WSTE-TV, Inc., will obtain sufficient additional funds with which to finance the construction and first-year operation of the station.
4. To determine whether a grant of the application would impair the ability of authorized and prospective UHF television broadcast stations in the area to compete effectively, or would jeopardize, in whole or in part, the continuation of existing UHF television service.
5. To determine whether WSTE-TV, Inc., concealed material facts with respect to the operation proposed in its various applications involving Station WSTE.
6. To determine the efforts made by WSTE-TV, Inc., to ascertain the community needs and interests of the area to be served and the means by which the applicant proposes to meet these needs and interests.
7. To determine, in the light of the evidence adduced pursuant to the foregoing issues, whether a grant of the above-captioned applications (BMPCT-5777) and BMPCT-6029) would serve the public interest, convenience and necessity."

WSTE-TV's original application for modification of CP was granted by the Commission on May 29, 1962. An appeal by WAPA-TV from the Commission decision to the U. S. Court of Appeals was remanded to the FCC on October 26, 1962, at Commission request, when it was learned that the record of WSTE-TV's requests before the Commission was incomplete. On May 27, 1964, WSTE-TV asked that action on its modification application be delayed while an effort was made to locate a better site. WSTE-TV filed its application for modification of construction permit on October 26, 1964. After a Federal Aviation Administration study showed that the proposed operation would interfere with Navy and FAA facilities, WSTE-TV amended its application on January 20, 1967, to contain its present requests.

About the History Cards ...

History Cards were first used by the Department of Commerce to keep track of applications filed by, and changes to, the earliest AM broadcast radio stations in the early 1920s. The records were subsequently transferred to the Federal Radio Commission in 1927, and after that to the Federal Communications Commission when that agency was created in 1934. These cards gradually grew into a large card file.

TV History Cards were initiated in the early 1940s, with the authorization of the earliest TV stations. History Cards remained in use until the creation of the first computerized database in 1980 to track broadcast applications, the Broadcast Application Processing System (BAPS). However, the Commission did not transfer the data from the History Cards to the new system. Instead, it retained the History Cards in their original form for reference.

In 1999, the Commission moved to a new location (445 12th Street SW), and also at that time created the successor database to BAPS, the Consolidated DataBase System (CDBS). Prior to that move, the History Cards were transferred to microfiche by a contractor (only a few sets of microfiche exist), and the original paper cards were destroyed. The History Cards were stored on the microfiche as negative images, like those you see above.

History Cards contain very brief entries and notes about station facilities, applications, and ownership. They are not, and never were intended to be, a comprehensive record of a station's operations. Nevertheless, they can be useful to help determine, for example, when a station first went on the air and its call letters at that time. History Card comments were generally typed onto the cards, and thus some records will show more faintly or with more smudging than others, depending on the quality of typewriter and ribbon then used. Occasional handwritten comments, corrections, and strikeouts may also be found. Cards may be incomplete, missing, or occasionally out of sequence.

The History Cards are presented here as they were copied to microfiche, to preserve this record for public use, and with the hope that they will be of value to future researchers of television station history.
