This is in reference to the request filed on July 12, 2018. Intelli requests an extension of the STA granted on September 17, 2014, to continue operating using the existing KZSJ(AM) tower to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application due to loss of the licensed site. In support of the request, Intelli states that it plans to file the application shortly.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and Intelli may continue to operate with the following facilities:
