
Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for W232CF, Fort Walton Beach, Florida.

An engineering study reveals the application is a major change application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 74.1233(a)(1). Specifically, Section 74.1233(a)(1) states that "a major change is any change in frequency (output channel) except changes to first, second or third adjacent channels, or intermediate frequency channels". The license (BLFT-20120613ABA) specifies Channel 232. The proposed application BPFT-20180710AAZ specifies Channel 255, or 23<sup>rd</sup> adjacent, which is a violation of Section 74.1233(a)(1). This was not addressed in the application. Because major change applications are not being accepted for filing, the application will be dismissed.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20180710AAZ filed by Omni Broadcasting, LLC, is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
