## <u>PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION</u> AND REINSTATEMENT *NUNC PRO TUNC*

Canyon Media Group, LLC ("Canyon"), by its attorneys, hereby petitions the Audio Division, Media Bureau, pursuant to Section 1.106 of the Commission's rules, to reconsider its dismissal of the above-captioned application for a construction permit for K253BU, Cedar City, Utah (the "Application") and accept that application *nunc pro tunc*. In support of this petition, the following is respectfully submitted:

- 1. The Application was submitted as a minor modification, changing the station's transmitter site and making other related changes. By letter dated August 8, 2018 ("Dismissal Letter"), the Audio Division dismissed the application. As discussed below, Canyon has submitted a curative amendment resolving the engineering defect apparently identified in the Letter and requests reinstatement of the Application *nunc pro tunc*.
- 2. The Application was dismissed because the Audio Division concluded that the Application did not properly address prohibited overlap with translator station K253BB, St.

George, Utah. By amendment being submitted simultaneously herewith, Canyon is correcting a typographical error in the initially filed application overstating the ground elevation of the proposed site. The amendment also demonstrates compliance with the rules, and protection to K235BB.

Therefore, for the reasons stated herein and in the amendment being submitted simultaneously herewith, Canyon requests that the Application be reinstated *nunc pro tunc* and that the amendment be accepted; and that the Application be processed towards grant.
