Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 13, 2018. CCL requests an extension of the STA granted on April 24, 2014, to operate with parameters at variance pending further action on BMML-20170713AIO filed to update all operating parameters.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we note the license application remains pending before the Commission at this time.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CCL may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power if needed based upon the information submitted in BMML-20170713AIO. CCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the


