The WHAK AM-FM studios are co-owned and co-located with WHSB and WWTH, a four station group with a commensurate staff that handles/controls station operations.

Of the four station group, the Form 314 seeks consent to assign WHAK AM only. The licensee will retain and operate 3 stations from the group.

I am advised that licensee employees charged with controlling and operating the co-located 4 station group prior to the LMA (including the licensee's on-site general manager, et. al.) are still on the licensee's staff and payroll and will remain responsible for WHAK AM operations through closing when the proposed assignee will assume control of the AM only.
