Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 6, 2018. CCBL requests an extension of the STA granted on March 16, 2018, to continue operating ND at night with reduced power to allow time to complete repairs.¹ In support of the request, CCBL states that additional time will be required to resolve all problems and resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WDIZ(AM) is licensed for operation on 590 kHz with 1.7 kW ND (day), and 2.5 kW DA (night).

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CCBL may continue to operate ND nighttime with a maximum of 0.625 kW or with DA parameters at variance while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits (with no change to the daytime licensed operation). CCBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.13 10. CCBL must submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-19860409AC with negligible changes to all operating parameters (to verify an FCC Form 302 filing is not required).

This authority expires on April 2, 2019.
