Request for tolling

Dear. Ms. Meredith:

This letter is to inform you that tolling was granted in error and is canceled for three construction permits for new FM Translator Stations: W270CS, Gulfport, Mississippi, File No. BNPFT-20150518AFL (Facility ID No. 142760), K221GE, Wickenburg, Arizona, File No. BNPFT-20130827AEC (Facility ID No. 143311), and K287BP, South Padre Island, Texas, File No. BNPFT-20130826AGH (Facility ID No. 142717) (collectively, Stations). Those permits were all granted on January 29, 2016, for three-year terms ending on January 29, 2019.

On March 8, 2018, we granted your tolling requests dated June 19, 2017, and February 5, 2018, for the Stations.<sup>1</sup> In your February 5, 2018, request, you stated that these stations were "tied up" in litigation and a bankruptcy proceeding, and that the court had ordered a stay which prevented you from building the stations. At that time, we found that your request was within the tolling provisions in 47 CFR § 73.3598(b) of the Commission's Rules.

Further review of the documentation in support of tolling indicates that the Stations are not part of the litigation or the bankruptcy matter and that they are not and never were eligible for tolling. Our grant of tolling was based on your false claim that the Stations were part of the litigation and subject to a stay order. Therefore, the expiration date will revert to the original date as though tolling had not occurred.
