Dear Mr. Standley:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 26, 2018. 321 requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 20, 2017, to continue operating at night with reduced power to allow time to rebuild one tower and file the required FCC Form 302 application. In support of the request, we note that 321 will need additional time to complete all repairs and file the application to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and 321 may continue to operate with 0.25 kW at night using the stations daytime directional antenna pattern (with no change to the licensed 5 kW daytime facility). 321 must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary

to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires April 23, 2019.
