Requests for Tolling

Dear Mr. Alpert,

On October 18, 2018, we received your request on behalf of Township Media, LLC, (TM), for tolling of the construction deadline for the construction permits for FM Stations KTHE, Llano, TX, Fac. ID No. 198631, File No. BMPH-20181010AAJ (modifying File No. BPH-20151007AGK) granted on November 19, 2015, for a three-year term, expiring on November 19, 2018 (KTHE permit) and KMSN, Fac. ID. No. 198632 File No. BMPH-20180717ABQ (modifying File No. BPH-20151007AGL), granted on November 10, 2015, for a three-year term, expiring on November 10, 2018 (KMSN permit). Your tolling requests are based on construction delays caused by damage and flooding in Texas Hill Country, which commenced on September 7, 2018. This request falls within one of the criteria for tolling in 47 CFR §73.3598(b)(1) and is granted.

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

Tolling is effective as of September 18, 2018.¹ When tolling ends, 63 days will remain on the KTHE permit and 54 days will remain on the KMSN permit.

Tolling will remain in effect for 6 months, until April 18, 2019, absent earlier resolution of the flooding conditions. If the matter is not resolved within 6 months, TM must file a status report by April 18, 2019, requesting continued tolling treatment.

TM must notify us within 30 days of the condition being resolved. All status reports must be sent by letter to Marlene S. Dortch, Secretary, FCC, 445 12 St, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554 with a courtesy copy by e-mail to Victoria McCauley at Victoria.McCauley@fcc.gov.

¹ Pursuant to §73.3598(c) of the rules, because the request was filed more than 30 days from grant of the original CP application, we look back 30 days from the date of filing to determine the effective date of tolling.

When tolling ends (either because TM has not filed a request for continued tolling or because the matter has been resolved) we will calculate a new CP expiration date by adding the remaining 63 days to the KTHE permit and 54 days to the KMSN permit.
