Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Oxenford:

This letter concerns the request you filed on September 25, 2018, on behalf of Stu-Comm, Inc. (SC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Translator Station W276BZ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that SC stated that Station W276BZ went silent on February 2, 2018, because it lost its programming source. The previous STA was granted on April 6, 2018, and expired on October 3, 2018. SC requests extension of its STA because of continuing programming issues. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

SC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W276BZ to remain silent until February 2, 2019. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W276BZ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., February 3, 2019.**<sup>1</sup>

SC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If SC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
