## Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for a minor change to a licensed facility construction permit to create an auxiliary facility.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of Section 73.807 of the Commission's Rules<sup>1</sup> in relation to construction permit BNPFT-20171204AAA for translator station W256DT, Shakopee, MN. The required separation is 39 kilometers, whereas the proposed separation is 29.7 kilometers.

LPFM modification applications must either meet the distance separation requirements or, if short spaced, not lessen the spacing to subsequent applications. The instant application reduces the spacing to BNPFT-20171204AAA from 31.1 kilometers to 29.7 kilometers.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BPL-20181018ABH is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>2</sup>
