Dear Mr. Usher:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 29, 2018. LCL requests an extension of the STA granted on June 15, 2017, to continue operating ND at night to allow time to restore licensed operations.¹ In support of the request, LCL states that equipment testing will be done in November in order to move forward toward resumption of licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

We note that the previous STA expired on August 12, 2018, therefore the authority granted herein will not cover the period between that date and the filing of this request, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation during that time period.

¹ KRGI(AM) is licensed for operation on 1430 kHz with 5 kW day (ND) and 1 kW night (DA).

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and LCL may continue to operate ND at night with a maximum of 0.25 kW or with nighttime DA parameters at variance and reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed limits (with no change to the licensed daytime operation). LCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. LCL must submit an e-mail to my attention to confirm the date the station resumed licensed operations with negligible changes, or the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed to update all operating parameters.

This authority expires on April 30, 2019.
