## Dear Applicant:

On August 24, 2009, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter for the following interference issue:

1. WDTV, Weston, WV. - BMPCDT-20080618ACH

The licensee was given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problem within (30) days from the date of that letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

We are currently processing your above-referenced application which includes the amended specifications of the September 4, 2009, amendment electronically filed. Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility still does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. WDTV, Weston, WV. - BMPCDT-20080618ACH

Please note as instructed by Video Management, effective September 1, 2009, the use of full service mask is no longer acceptable until it becomes part of FCC technical rules; therefore, this analyzes is based on the mask type as filed in the proposed construction permit.

Since the amendment did not resolve the deficiency as addressed in the 30 day letter of August 24, 2009, the above referenced application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
