This is in reference to the request filed on October 29, 2018. URL requests a further extension of the STA granted on August 6, 2010, to continue operating from an alternate site pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 license application. In support of the request, we noted that URL has not yet filed the 302 applications for WVNA and WLAY due to the related assignment application (BAL-20181018AAP).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and URL may
