Tolling Request

Dear Mr. Deutsch:

On November 26, 2018, we accepted your request filed on behalf of Texas Public Radio (TPR), for tolling of the construction deadline for the construction permit for Station KTPR(FM), Stanton, Texas (Station), Fac. ID No. 172898, granted on November 15, 2018, a three-year term, expiring on November 15, 2021 (File No. BPED-20171115AAW). The grant is conditioned on receiving concurrence from the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) for the use of the Station's channel. This request falls within one of the criteria for tolling, and is granted. *See* 47 C.F.R §73.3598(b); *1998 Biennial Regulatory Review—Streamlining of Mass Media Application Rules and Processes*, Report and Order, 13 FCC Rcd 23056 (1998) ("*Streamlining R&O*"), *recon. granted in part and denied in part*, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 14 FCC Rcd 17525, 17540 (1999) ("*Streamlining MO&O*"). Pursuant to §73.3598(c) of the rules, this request is timely filed. **I have placed a note in the Station's record in our public database indicating that RFS's request has been granted, effective November 15, 2018.**

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

Tolling is effective as of **November 15, 2018**. When tolling ends, the full three-year term will remain on the permit.

Tolling will remain in effect until May 27, 2019, absent earlier resolution of the condition. If the matter is not resolved within 6 months, you would need to file a status report by May 27, 2019, and at six-month intervals thereafter, requesting continued tolling treatment.

You also must notify us within 30 days of the condition being resolved. These status reports must be sent by letter to Marlene S. Dortch, Secretary, FCC, 445 12 St, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554 with a courtesy copy by e-mail to Victoria McCauley at victoria.mccauley@fcc.gov.

When tolling ends (either because you have not filed a request for continued tolling or because the matter has been resolved) we will calculate a new permit expiration date by adding the remaining three years.
