Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned application for K243BO, Roma, Texas.

Our review of the application has revealed that the proposal violates Sections 2.1.1 and 2.1.2 of the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Mexican States Relating to the FM Broadcasting Service in the Band 88-108 MHz.


Section 2.1.1 requires that the proposed 54 dB $\mu$  interfering contour can not overlap with the 60 dB $\mu$  protected contour of Mexican FM allotments and assignments. The proposed translator is approximately 25.5 kilometers from two Mexican Allotments for CD. Miguel Aleman, MX on Channel 242A and 244A. The Mexican stations' protected contours extends 24 kilometers.

Section 2.1.1 requires that the proposed 100 dB $\mu$  interfering contour can not overlap with the 60 dB $\mu$  protected contour of Mexican FM allotments and assignments. The proposed translator is approximately 28.1 kilometers from Mexican Allotment for Ciudad Miguel Aleman, MX on Channel 240AA. The Mexican station's protected contour extends 28 kilometers.

Section 2.1.2 requires that proposed translator can not exceed 50 watts and 34 dBu contour more than 32 kilometers in the direction of Mexico. Between radials 110-140 degrees True and 270-320 degrees True, the proposed facility violates the 50 watts and 32 kilometer requirements.

Accordingly, Application BPFT-20180723ABA IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
