REQUEST FOR TOLLING AND EXTENSION

Re: K236CD, Facility ID#: 156909, El Paso, Texas

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This request is submitted on behalf of MCCLATCHEY BROADCASTING, INC. ("McClatchey"), licensee of FM translator station K236CD, Tucson, AZ (Facility ID 156909), regarding the tolling of time to return to the air in light of the terminal illness of the station's owner.

On May 1, 2017, the applicant requested silent authority. That application was granted by FCC letter dated May 12, 2017. The letter from the FCC noted that the license would automatically expire on April 30, 2018 if the station was not returned to the air by that date.

Attached hereto is a letter from Julie Zuniga NP, FNP-C, who attended Mr. Arnold McClatchey during his terminal illness. As stated therein, he was admitted to the hospital on October 20, 2017 with a fracture of his right femur, kidney failure and delirium. His medical issues continued until his death on June 20, 2018. During that time period, he was "never able to return to work." As a result, Mr. McClatchey, sole proprietor of the licensee during the time period from his hospitalization (October 20, 2017) until the expiration of the license (April 30, 2018), was unable to attend to the business of placing K236CD back on the air.

Under the circumstances, his terminal illness (being clearly a matter beyond his control), it is respectfully requested that the Commission grant tolling for the period beginning October 20, 2017 until the present. This is needed to give the current licensee time to put the translator back on the air. Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that an additional period of time of six months and 10 days (October 20 to April 30), commencing with the date tolling is granted, to put the station back on the air.
