Dear Mr. Robbins:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 11, 2007, on behalf of Call Communications Group, Inc. ("CCG"). CCG requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 16, 2007, and modified on April 19, 2007, for operation of Station WMKL with temporary facilities. In support of its request, CCG states that it has been unable to obtain permission from the current tower owner to replace its antenna; that it filed an application for modification of construction permit to specify a new tower location, that its application was dismissed by the staff for a minor short-spacing violation and that the filing of a corrective amendment was delayed by the Commission's "freeze" on the filing of minor change applications in connection with the recent noncommercial FM new/major change filing window.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due

to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WMKL may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates: 25° 14′ 07" N, 80° 19′ 35" W (NAD 1927)

Channel 220 (91.9 MHz)

Effective radiated power: not to exceed 25 kilowatts (H&V)

Antenna height:

above ground: 91 meters above mean sea level: 94 meters Above average terrain: 94 meters

CCG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on October 1, 2008.
