Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. O'Connor:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 28, 2018, on behalf of First Assembly King's Cathedral & Chapels (FAKCC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station KKON to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that FAKCC stated that Station KKON(AM) went silent on June 13, 2018, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on July 6, 2018, and expired on January 2, 2019. FAKCC requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

FAKCC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KKON(AM) to remain silent until June 13, 2019. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KKON(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., June 14, 2019.**<sup>1</sup>

FAKCC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If FAKCC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
