Dear Mr. Liu:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 27, 2019. MRB requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on January 11, 2007, to continue ND operation at night pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application due to redevelopment of the transmitter site.¹ In support of the request, MRB states that additional time will be needed to file the application after the proposed rules mentioned in the AM revitalization order (MB Docket No.13-249) become effective.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and MRB may

continue to operate ND with a maximum power of 1 kW day and 0.125 kW at night using tower #1. MRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. MRB must file the application immediately after the proposed rules in the revitalization order have become effective.²

This authority expires on **September 12, 2019**.
