The staff has under consideration the above-captioned modification application for a minor change to a licensed facility.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807 in relation to co-channel license for KDLZ-LP, BLL-20190222ABW, in Yolano, CA. The minimum required separation is 24 kilometers, whereas the separation proposed is 11.9 kilometers. The modification application for KDLZ-LP has been dismissed thereby not allowing this short spacing to be dissolved.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BPL-20190311AAK is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
