Dear Mr. Cherry:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 15, 2019. Cherry requests a further extension of the STA granted on February 10, 2015, as modified to continue operating at an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we note that the application to cover BP-20180907ADW has not yet been filed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and Cherry may continue to operate with the facilities shown below:
