Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Kelly:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 19, 2019, on behalf of Covenant Network (CN), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WIHM to go silent.

CN's request states that Station WIHM(AM) went silent on February 8, 2019, for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

CN's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WIHM(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WIHM(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., February 9, 2020.¹

CN is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If CN does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
