Dear Mr. Angulo:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 20, 2019. ARC requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on October 29, 2004, to continue ND operation pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, we note that ARC did not yet file the application to cover BP-20170427AAE.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and ARC may continue to operate ND using a maximum of 0.625 kW. ARC must use whatever means are

necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 1, 2019**.
