Bloomberg Radio Newburyport, LLC ("Bloomberg") and Blount Communications, Inc. of NH ("Blount") hereby jointly request an additional 60 day extension of time for Bloomberg to respond to your above-referenced letter of February 15, 2019 asking Bloomberg to submit information as to the resolution of complaints claiming interference from its translator W221EE, Newburyport, MA to the reception of Blount's WDER-FM, Peterborough, New Hampshire. The parties are working on a possible engineering solution that would resolve the concerns raised in Blount's "Petition to Deny" filed against the W221EE license application. Discussions between engineers and principals of the parties have taken place, and engineering studies and other technical work is also underway.

Because of intervening industry events (including the NRB and NAB Conventions) and other events, and the inherent time it takes to study these issues, more time is needed. As a solution toward which the parties are working could resolve the matter without the need for Commission intervention, saving the resources of the Commission and the parties, an extension to facilitate these discussions is justified, particularly as both parties agree to this course of action.
