West Virginia Educational Broadcasting Authority ("WVEBA"), licensee of noncommercial FM radio station WQAB(FM), Facility ID No. 908, Philippi, West Virginia ("Station"), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") that it has permanently discontinued operation of the Station and is surrendering the Station license for cancellation.<sup>1</sup> WVEBA respectfully requests the Commission update its records to reflect the cancellation of the license for the Station.

The Station was silent without Commission authorization at the time WVEBA acquired it on May 31, 2017. WVEBA diligently worked to bring the Station back into service but was unable to do so prior to August 13, 2018.
