Request for Extension of Special Temporary

Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Rosbury:

This letter concerns the request you filed on May 16, 2019, on behalf of Living Free in Christ Church, Inc. (LFCCI), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit Low-Power FM Radio Station WRRQ-LP to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that LFCCI stated that Station WRRQ-LP went silent on September 24, 2018, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on November 27, 2018, and expired on May 26, 2019. LFCCI requests extension of its STA for continuing financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

LFCCI's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WRRQ-LP to remain silent until September 24, 2019. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WRRQ-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 25, 2019.

LFCCI is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If LFCCI does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
