This letter is in reference to the above-captioned license for Radio Station KGLH(FM) on Channel 218D in Gerlach, Nevada.

The license for KGLH(FM) expired on October 1, 1990. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §73.1020 and §73.3539, South Carolina radio stations wishing to renew their operating authority were required to file license renewal applications by October 1, 1990. Renewal applications were sent to KGLH on April 5, 1991 and again on March 20, 1992 along with letters reminding the station of its obligation to submit the form as soon as possible. As of the date of this letter, we have no record of receiving any such application from your station. Furthermore, based on recent phone conversations with your staff, the station has not been operational for a number of years. Thus, your authority to operate station KGLH(FM) terminated in 1990.

Furthermore, as a Class D station seeking renewal of license for a term expiring after June 1, 1980, KGLH(FM) was required (if possible) to upgrade its facilities or change channels in accordance with 47 C.F.R. §73.512(a). See Second Report and Order, Docket 20735, 43 Fed. Reg. 39704 (1978). The Commission's records do not reflect that any action has been taken to bring KGLH(FM) into compliance with § 73.512. Accordingly, even had the appropriate license renewal application been filed, it would not have granted absent compliance with § 73.512.

Based on the foregoing, we conclude that your authority to operate pursuant to BLED-800428AA has terminated. Accordingly, license BLED-800428AA IS HEREBY CANCELLED and call letters KGLH(FM) ARE HEREBY DELETED. These actions are taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283 and 47 U.S.C. §307(c)¹. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.104(b) you may file a petition for reconsideration within thirty days of the Public Notice date of this action. In order to be considered favorably, such a petition must satisfy all pertinent requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 1.106.
